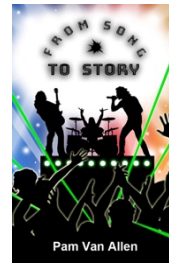
No matter the size of the body of water

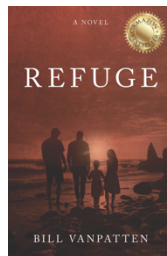
