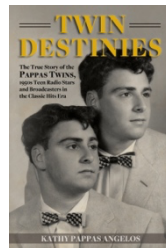
From “Baba’s Accordion”

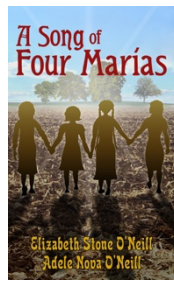
The husband approached his wife for a kiss, but she didn’t move from her post at the sink. He squeezed her shoulders instead.

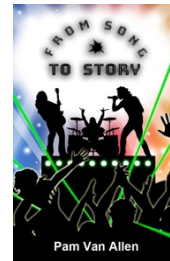
